



2023 SUMMER STAFF JOB DESCRIPTIONS

YOUTH CAMP PROGRAM:

Counselor – oversee a cabin of campers for a week-long overnight program; typically a 1 to 6 ratio; lead and discuss Bible studies; lead cabin group through daily activities; be involved in camp activities and lead some events; be self-motivated, mature and have a desire to point campers to Jesus Christ while supporting the entire camp team. Counselors must be at least 18 years old and out of high school.

Activities Coordinator – plan and lead daily recreation program including small and large group games; be an energetic leader, comfortable speaking and leading in front of groups and able to communicate clearly.

HAVEN CAMP PROGRAM:

Counselor – care for special needs campers in a week-long overnight program; typically a 1 to 3 or 4 ratio; provide coaching and teaching in daily life skills including monitoring and support of basic hygiene needs; ensure care plans are followed as given by nursing staff and Haven Camp Director; assist campers to acclimate to the camp grounds and assist them as needed to engage and participate in camp activities.

Program Director – responsible for leading and managing the daily camp program in conjunction with the Haven Camp Director; develop and lead Bible lesson curriculum and activities; ensure communication of program needs are monitored and maintained; assist counselors where needed; take appropriate and prudent action in emergency situations.

Art Director – responsible to develop, plan and lead arts & crafts for Haven Camp programs; work with the Haven Camp Program Director to establish appropriate and engaging projects for campers; assist counselors where needed.

Music Director – responsible to develop, plan and lead music for Haven Camp programs; work closely with the Haven Camp Program Director to establish music needs during services and other times throughout the week; assist counselors where needed.

Night Watch – work the overnight shift in the Main Lodge; walking the building and checking each room periodically through the night; may have individual campers who need to be woken; take appropriate and prudent action in emergency situations.

SUPPORT STAFF:

Lifeguard – oversee the maintenance and safety of the waterfront (swim & boating area); lead and oversee waterfront activities; will be assigned clean-up tasks around camp as well as serving in the snack shop.

Waterfront Director – oversee all operations at the waterfront including lifeguards and activities; must be at least 21 years old, have 3 seasons of waterfront experience, must be CPR certified and have Lifeguard Supervision & Management certification.

Kitchen Workers – assist cooks in food preparation; kitchen clean up and various other kitchen tasks as assigned by the Food Service Director including doing dishes, helping in snack shop and keeping vending machines filled; have a strong work ethic and be dependable; must be at least 18 years old.

Maintenance – assist Facilities Director with general maintenance and cleaning of campgrounds and facilities; have a strong work ethic and be dependable; must be at least 18 years old.

Night Watch – work late afternoon until middle of night; assist with camp programs until curfew; walk the grounds and monitor activities throughout camp; must be at least 18 years old.

Office/Bookkeeping Assistant – help with camp clerical work including answering phones, taking messages, filing and helping with the staff and camper bank accounts; must be at least 18 years old.

Photographer – assist in taking and editing pictures through all aspects of the camp program including activities with campers and staff; experience with photography needed; flexible to be pulled into other areas of camp to assist.

Videographer – assist in taking and editing video through all aspects of the camp program including activities with campers and staff; experience with video is a must; flexible to be pulled into other areas of camp to assist.

Childcare – responsible to be a nanny for young children whose mother is on staff.

Nurse – must have current RN, LPN, or PA license in New York State; must have current CPR/AED certification; assist in camp program healthcare operations; respond to emergencies; process and maintain health records.
